





### Breed Highlight Chow Chow

Chow Chow Starring Miska.

Known for their distinctive black tongue, the Chow Chow is possibly one of the world's oldest breeds.

Tracing a heritage back to 200 bc, Chows have had many roles during their history. They were the companions nobles. But over the centuries they also earned their keep as guardians, herders, cart pullers and hunters.

Chinese legends mention large war dogs from central Asia that resembled black-tongued lions. Some historians believe that the Chow Chow was the dog described as accompanying the Mongolian armies as they invaded southward into China as well as west into Europe.

### Dogs, Translated!

Why does my dog tilt their head when I talk to them!

Not just a cute face, when a dog tilts their head they are often processing what you are saying. Usually in response to familiar words. It's their way of saying 'I'm listening!'

It can also be a way to pin point the location of a sound. By shifting one ear closer at a time they can measure the time it takes the sound to reach the ear, and figure out where the noise is coming from.
